

KOREAN VISA REQUIREMENTS

For Foreign Resident in the Philippines

Reminder:

For nationals of below countries who are applying for Korean visa at the Embassy of the Republic of Korea in the Republic of the Philippines, only those who possess Philippine long-term residence visa (marriage visa, working visa, student visa, retiree's visa, permanent resident visa, and others) and have continuously stayed in the Philippines for more than 2 years will be allowed to apply.

If nationals of below countries have stayed in the Philippines for less than 2 years, or do not possess Philippine long-term residence visa, they must apply for Korean visa at the consulate in the country of their origin.

- China, Thailand, India, Indonesia, Mongol, Vietnam, Myanmar, Bangladesh, Pakistan, Sri Lanka, Nepal
- Iran, Iraq, Syria, Palestine, Yemen
- Uzbekistan, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Afghanistan
- Nigeria, Ghana, Egypt, Sudan, Cameroon, Somalia, Gambia, Senegal
- Cuba, Peru, Ukraine, Kosovo, Macedonia

1. Application Form
2. 1 piece of Passport size colored picture (Please attach on the application form)
3. Original Passport (should be valid for more than 6months)
4. Photocopy of Passport Bio-page (page 2)
5. Original & Photocopy of valid visa/s and arrival stamps to OECD member countries for the past 5 years (If applicable)
6. Photocopy of ACR I-Card, Philippine long-term visa, and arrival stamps to Philippines
7. Personal Bank Certificate Original [must include account type, current balance, account opening date, 6 months average balance (ADB)]
8. Personal Bank Statement (original or certified true copy of bank statements/passbook for the last 3 months)
9. Bank Statement - original or certified true copy of bank statements/passbook for the last 3 months
10. **If Student:** Original School Certificate and Photocopy of School ID
If Employee: Original Certificate of Employment (must include applicant's position, date hired, compensation, office address, HR landline number(cell-phone number is not allowed), HR e-mail address), Photocopy of ITR(Income Tax Return) or Form 2316 Copy
If Businessman: Photocopy of SEC or DTI, Mayor's Permit, Photocopy of ITR (Income Tax Return) or Form 2316 with corresponding payment receipt from BIR authorized bank

- If personally invited by Korean
 - Invitation Letter
 - Photocopy of inviter's Passport or Identification Card (authentication not required)

- If invited by Company in Korea
 - Invitation Letter
 - Photocopy of Korean Company Business Permit (authentication not required)

- Frequent travellers who have travelled as tourist to OECD member countries within 5 years are exempted from submitting ITR.

Visa Fee: Single Entry – PHP2,700.00
Multiple Entry – PHP5,200.00
(fee may differ for some nationalities)
