

JAPAN TOURIST VISA REQUIREMENTS

1. Passport (Holder's signature needed)
2. Application Form (Typewritten)
3. Facial Photo (45mm x 35mm must be attached to application form)
4. Birth Certificate (issued by PSA within 1 year)
 - a. If the certificate is unreadable, submit Birth Certificate issued by Local Civil Registrar. (Copy)
 - b. If the Birth Certificate is "LATE REGISTRATION" submit Baptismal Certificate & School Form 137. (Copy)
 - c. If there is no record of birth in PSA, submit Birth Certificate issued by Local Civil Registrar and Negative Certificate from PSA
5. Marriage Certificate (issued by PSA within 1 year, for married only)
 - a. If the certificate is unreadable, submit Marriage Certificate issued by Local Civil Registrar. (Copy)
 - b. If there is no record of marriage in PSA, submit Marriage Certificate issued by Local Civil Registrar and Negative Certificate from PSA
6. Daily Itinerary in Japan (Downloadable in our website)
7. Bank Certificate (Original and Copy)
8. Photocopy of Income Tax Return
(BIR Form 2316, 1701 Page 1-4 or 1700 Page 1-2)
9. Authorization Letter (Downloadable in our website)

In case that applicant has no financial documents (No. 7 & 8), a guarantor must provide the following:

- Guarantee Letter (Downloadable in our website)
- Proof of relationship (through PSA Documents)
- Bank Certificate (Original and Copy)
- Photocopy of Income Tax Return
(BIR Form 2316, 1701 Page 1-4 or 1700 Page 1-2)
- Photocopy of Passport/Valid Government ID
(And Valid Japan Visa if available)

Others:

-If you wish to apply for a multiple entry visa, you must fill-out the Multiple Entry Visa Form (Subject for embassy's approval)

Note: Item nos. 2, 4a, 4b, 5a, 6, 7, 8, 9, Guarantor's Guarantee Letter / Bank Certificate / Income Tax Return / Passport/Valid Government ID and Multiple Entry Visa Form must be printed/copied in A4 size paper.
